Use this feeding chart to help you determine how to feed your pet the healthiest, most nutritious dog food on the planet.

BARF Diet Patties

Weight of dog	Puppy	High Performance	Average Activity
(lbs)	Required Number of Patties per Day		
12 lbs	1 1/2	1	1/2
25 lbs	3	2	1
50 lbs	6	4	2
100 lbs	12	8	4

BARF Diet Nuggets

Weight of dog	Puppy	High Performance	Average Activity
(lbs)	Required Number of Cups* per Day		
12 lbs	3	2	1
25 lbs	6	4	2
50 lbs	12	8	4

*1 cup serving = approximately 15 nuggets

To thaw, remove from bag, place in a container with a lid and defrost in the refrigerator. Do not re-freeze the BARF patties and nuggets once they have been thawed. Food will spoil if left unrefrigerated for an extended period of time. Excess food should be refrigerated for the next feeding or discarded.

**All raw meat products may contain bacteria that could cause illness if mishandled. Treat the BARF patties and nuggets as you would any raw meat product. Wash working surfaces, utensils and hands with hot soapy water after each feeding.
